Donations and Community Activities



Donation Ministry of Security

AES donated medical protection equipment to the Ministry Public Security in Panama.

The donation consists of 22.000 masks, 187 glove boxes and 800 alcohol bottles; totaling an amount of over USD \$30k. These items will be used by the public security officials of this institution that work every day in support of the national efforts to bring relief to the communities and stop the spread of the disease.

AES in Panamá will continue to work in alliance with our partners to preserve the safety of our communities and the country.







Repairs for Food Storage Facility

AES repaired the storage facilities for the packing of food items that will be distributed to vulnerable families in the province of Chiriquí, the facilities belong to the Institute of Agricultural Marketing (IMA).

IMA is in charge of promoting the agricultural sector in the commercialization and marketing of the different products. In the face of the pandemic they are storing and packing food bags to be delivered to families economically affected by the situation. The repairs exceeded USD \$10k and consisted of electrical works and general repairs of the warehouse to be able to store the items.

AES in Panamá will continue to work in alliance with our partners help families and communities that are facing difficult situations due to the pandemic.



Support to Firefighters

AES donated medical protection equipment to the Fire Department of Panama.

The donation consists of 500 mask boxes, 400 protective suits, 60 units of germicide liquid, and 4 fogger pumps sanitation units; totaling an amount of over USD \$40k. These items will be used by the firefighters, that in face of this pandemic are working every day to sanitize public spaces and hospitals, and to deliver medicines to the elderly who cannot leave their houses.

AES in Panamá will continue to work in alliance with our partners to bring support to help those in need and stop the spread of the virus.





Food for vulnerable families in Colón and Chiriquí

AES donated bags of food to the Municipality of Colón and the government of Chiriquí.

The 1500 food bags that were donated contain essential items and food for a household to last for 1 month. They will be distributed by the local authorities to the most vulnerable sectors of the province of Colón and Chiriquí, where families are facing difficult economical situations and are not able to buy food. This donations totaled an amount of over USD \$32k.

AES in Panamá will continue to work in alliance with our partners to help neighboring families and communities that are facing harsh situations due to the pandemic.



Investment in ventilator project

AES has invested in a university project that is elaborating a prototype of a ventilator to help COVID-19 patients.

Due to the lack of ventilators in the country, the Technological University of Panamá (UTP) has embarked into an investigation project to elaborate ventilators to help patients suffering from respiratory issues due to Covid-19. As a company that supports innovation and technology, AES has decided to invest 30k to this cause. We look forward to the successful completion of the equipment and believe the ventilators will help spare many lives in the country.

AES in Panamá will continue to work in alliance with our partners to bring support to patients that are fighting against this virus and help those in need.







Payment of electricity bill for major hospital

AES has decided to cover electric bill for a main hospital of the Panamanian Social Security Service.

Arnulfo Arias Madrid Medical Complex is one of the main public hospitals in the country, and its is now the major center for attending Covid-19 patients. Flooded with patients and medical staff the hospital is facing many over costs due to the sanitary emergency. AES decided to relieve some of the financial burden the hospital is suffering by covering the electricity bill for the months of April and May, the peak months for the virus in Panama. The amount of these bills will exceed USD \$530k, which AES will be able to cover as the hospital is a direct client of the company.

AES in Panamá will continue to work in alliance with our partners and the government to bring support to patients that are fighting against this virus and help the medical staff that is continually serving us.
